INTRODUCTORY NOTES

VARIOUS PARTS OF THE MASS

1. The *Gloria* is sung (said) on Sundays (outside Advent and Lent), on solemnities and on feasts, during the octaves of Christmas and Easter and at special solemn celebrations.
2. There is only ever one *Collect, Prayer over the Gifts, and Prayer after Communion*. Mention of any other need or anniversary is made in the Prayer of the Faithful.
3. The *weekday readings* ought to be used on their appointed days, except when there occurs a solemnity, a feast, or a memorial with proper readings. The priest may add the weekday readings which have been thus omitted to the readings of the previous or following days (provided that the sense is retained) in order that continuity be preserved. He may also choose between the readings omitted.
- In Masses for special groups it is permissible for the priest to choose readings more appropriate to the group, provided that the readings are taken from among those of the approved lectionary.
4. The *Creed* is said on all Sundays and solemnities, and also on special occasions.
5. In *Masses which have a proper Preface* it is not permitted to use a Eucharistic Prayer (e.g. Eucharistic Prayer 4) having an obligatory Preface which affects the unity of that Eucharistic Prayer. An exception is made in Lent where a Lenten weekday preface may be used with a Eucharistic Prayer for Reconciliation.
6. It is highly appropriate that the faithful receive *Holy Communion* from Hosts consecrated at the same Mass, and that, as permitted, they also receive from the chalice. In this way their sharing in the Sacrifice being celebrated is more apparent. (see also page 4)

MASS FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE PARISH

The Parish Priest is obliged to offer Mass for the people in his care each Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation. If he is lawfully unable to do this, the Mass must be celebrated on the appropriate day by another priest or on a different day by himself. If the priest has care of more than one parish, one Mass offered for all the people in his care suffices. The days of obligation are indicated in the *Ordo* by a cross: + (see also page 11)

MASS FOR THE DEAD

1. A Funeral Mass may be celebrated on any day except Holy Days of Obligation, Holy Thursday and the Easter Triduum, and Sundays of Advent, Lent and Eastertide.
2. A Mass for the Dead may be celebrated on the news of death and on the **first** anniversary of death even on the days of the Christmas Octave on which no feast occurs, obligatory memorials, and all weekdays (including Advent, Christmastide, Lent and Eastertide) except Ash Wednesday, Holy Week and the Easter Octave.
3. The 'daily' Mass for the Dead may be celebrated only on Weekdays of Ordinary Time when there is no obligatory memorial.
4. In Masses for the Dead purple vestments are preferred to black. White may be used at funerals.

MASSES FOR VARIOUS NEEDS AND VOTIVE MASSES

1. Given the facility of choice in selecting prayers and readings at Mass, Masses for Various Needs and Votive Masses should be celebrated only when a genuine pastoral need exists. In these Masses the weekday readings and chants may always be used, unless they are not apt for the particular celebration.
2. Ritual Masses, connected to the celebration of a sacrament or sacramental, are not permitted on the Sundays of Advent, Lent and Eastertide, on solemnities, during the Easter Octave, on All Souls Day, Ash Wednesday and during Holy Week, unless the contrary is indicated in the Ritual or in the particular Ritual Mass.

3. A Mass for a genuine necessity or for the pastoral good (e.g. the First Friday Mass) may be celebrated with the people even when there is an obligatory memorial or Advent weekday (before 17th December), during Christmastide (from 2nd January) and Eastertide (except the Octave) when a Votive Mass would not normally be permitted.

4. When Marriage takes place during Mass the Wedding Mass is celebrated, except on Sundays and solemnities, when the Mass of the day is celebrated (the Nuptial Blessing and final Blessing from the Wedding Mass being retained). One of the readings at Mass may always be taken from the selection for Marriage except on Easter Sunday and on Holy Days of Obligation. The Wedding Mass may be celebrated even on Sundays of Christmastide and of Ordinary Time if the parish community is not taking part.

SUMMARY OF RUBRICS GOVERNING RITUAL MASSES, MASSES FOR VARIOUS NEEDS AND OCCASIONS, AND MASSES FOR THE DEAD

Abbreviations

V1 = Ritual Masses (*General Instruction* of the Roman Missal #330), and Masses for Various Needs and Occasions and votive Masses, in cases of serious need or pastoral advantage, at the discretion of the local Ordinary, or with his permission. (*GI* 332)

V2 = Masses for Various Needs and Occasions and votive Masses, in cases of serious need or pastoral advantage, at the discretion of the parish priest or the celebrating priest. (*GI* 333)

V3 = Masses for Various Needs and Occasions and votive Masses chosen by the celebrating priest for the devotion of the faithful. (*GI* 329 b & c)

D1 = Funeral Mass. (*GI* 336)

D2 = Mass celebrated on receiving news of death, Mass of final burial, or on the first anniversary. (*GI* 337)

D3 = Daily Mass for the Dead (*GI* 337). When D1 and D2 are not permitted neither is D3

+ = permitted - = not permitted

Holy days of obligation, Sundays of Advent, Lent and Eastertide, Holy Thursday and Easter Triduum: -V1; -D1

Solemnities not of obligation, All Souls, Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, Easter Octave: -V1; +D1

Sundays of Christmastide and Ordinary Time, Feasts: +V1; -V2; +D1; -D2

Obligatory memorials, Advent weekdays before 17 December, Christmas weekdays from 2 January, Eastertide weekdays: +V1; +V2; +D1; +D2

COMMEMORATIONS

Memorials which occur on weekdays from 17th to 31st December and during Lent (except Ash Wednesday and Holy Week) may be celebrated in this way:

- a) In the Office of Readings the hagiographical reading and responsory and prayer of the saint may be inserted after the second reading and its responsory.
- b) At Lauds and Vespers the conclusion of the prayer of the day is omitted and the antiphon and prayer of the saint added.
- c) At Mass of the current day the collect may be that of the saint.

DAYS OF PENANCE

1. Days of penance for all the Latin Church are all Fridays and the Season of Lent.
2. Abstinence from meat, or from some other food determined by the Episcopal Conference, is to be observed on all Fridays, except when a solemnity falls on a Friday. Abstinence and fasting are to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.
3. All are bound by the law of abstinence who have reached the age of fourteen. The law of fasting applies to all who have attained their majority (18) until after their fifty-ninth birthday. Pastors of souls and parents should ensure that even those who are too young to be bound by the laws of fasting and abstinence are trained to have a true appreciation of penance.
4. The Episcopal Conference may substitute other forms of penance (e.g. works of charity, devotional exercises) in place of abstinence or fasting.

HOLY COMMUNION

a) The Fast

1. Whoever is to receive the blessed Eucharist is to abstain for at least one hour before holy communion from all food and drink, except water and medicine, whether liquid or solid.
2. A priest who, on the same day, celebrates the blessed Eucharist twice or three times may consume something before the second or third celebration, even though there is not an hour's interval.
3. The elderly and those who are suffering from some illness, as well as those who have care for them, may receive the blessed Eucharist even if within the preceding hour they have consumed something.

b) The Easter Precept

Once admitted to the blessed Eucharist, each of the faithful is obliged to receive holy communion at least once a year. This precept must be fulfilled during paschal time, unless for good reason it is fulfilled at some other time of the year.

c) Other Matters

1. Anyone who is conscious of grave sin may not receive the Body and Blood of the Lord without previously having been to sacramental confession, unless there is a grave reason and there is no opportunity to confess; in this case the person is to remember the obligation to make a perfect act of contrition, which includes the resolve to go to confession as soon as possible.
2. One who has received the blessed Eucharist may receive it a second time on the same day only within a Mass in which the person participates.
3. It is primarily the duty of parents and of those who take their place, as it is the duty of the parish priest, to ensure that children who have reached the age of reason are properly prepared and, having made their sacramental confession, are nourished by this divine food as soon as possible. It is also the duty of the parish priest to see that children who have not reached the age of reason, or whom he has judged to be insufficiently disposed, do not come to holy communion.

PARISH CELEBRATIONS

In each parish the titular saint's day or the mystery commemorated in the title of the church is kept as a solemnity, using texts from either the proper or the commons. So also the day of the dedication (i.e. consecration) of the church (if it is dedicated) using texts from the Common of the Dedication of a Church.

(Suggested: I Is 56:1,6-7. Ps 83:3-5,10-11. II Eph 2:19-22. G Lk 19:1-10)

In chapels-of-ease the celebration of the title is kept as a solemnity; in the rest of the parish it is kept as a feast.

THE CYCLE OF PRAYER

1. We are asked to pray for the intentions set out in the Cycle in our personal prayers throughout the period specified, and not only at Mass on a particular day. It is hoped that this will ensure that a Day of Special Prayer does not detract from the authentic celebration of the Lord's Day.

2. In addition to private and communal prayer, it is hoped that there will be active and practical support for certain areas of Christian concern, such as peace, unity, evangelisation, the sick, and the welfare of prisoners and their families.

3. In connection with intentions in the Cycle of Prayer, the use on a weekday of Masses for Various Needs and Occasions or Votive Masses is recommended. When it is desired to have a form of extended prayer for one of the intentions in the Cycle of Prayer, consideration should be given to holding a special service (other than Mass) for that purpose, such as a Vigil, the Evening Prayer of the Church, a Liturgy of the Word, a procession with litanies, or Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament.

Let us pray for young people who are preparing for marriage with the support of a Christian community: may they grow in love, with generosity, faithfulness and patience.

JULY

Universal Intention - *Social friendship*

We pray that, in social, economic and political situations of conflict, we may be courageous and passionate architects of dialogue and friendship.

AUGUST

Intention for evangelisation - *The Church*

Let us pray for the Church, that she may receive from the Holy Spirit the grace and strength to reform herself in the light of the Gospel.

SEPTEMBER**Universal Intention - *An environmentally sustainable lifestyle***

We pray that we all will make courageous choices for a simple and environmentally sustainable lifestyle, rejoicing in our young people who are resolutely committed to this

OCTOBER**Intention for evangelisation - *Missionary disciples***

We pray that every baptised person may be engaged in evangelisation, available to the mission, by being witnesses of a life that has the flavour of the Gospel.

NOVEMBER**Universal Intention - *People who suffer from depression***

We pray that people who suffer from depression or burn-out will find support and a light that opens them up to life.

DECEMBER**Intention for evangelisation - *Catechists***

Let us pray for catechists, summoned to announce the Word of God: may they be its witnesses, with courage and creativity and in the power of the Holy Spirit.

NOTES FOR THE CLERGY

Deanery Conferences for the priests meet on the second Tuesday of February, March, September, November and December.

The Priests' Retreat usually takes place in the last full week in July.

HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION

1. The solemnities of the **Epiphany of the Lord** (6th January), **Ss Peter and Paul** (29th June), **the Assumption of Our Lady** (15th August), and **All Saints** (1st November) are celebrated as days of obligation on their respective dates, except when they would occur on a Monday or a Saturday, in which case they are celebrated on the nearest Sunday. The solemnity of **the Ascension of the Lord** is celebrated on the Thursday after the Sixth Sunday of Easter. The solemnity of the **Nativity of the Lord** is always celebrated on 25th December. The solemnity of the **Body and Blood of Christ** is now assigned to the second Sunday after Pentecost.

2. Following a request for information the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales submitted a dubium to the Pontifical Commission *Ecclesia Dei* which confirmed that in the Roman Rite, whichever form of the liturgy is being celebrated, the Holy Days of Obligation are held in common. Where the obligation has been removed and the Holy Day transferred to the Sunday (The Body and Blood of Christ), and when, as in England and Wales, the Holy Day would fall on a Monday or Saturday, this is to be followed in both Ordinary and Extraordinary Celebrations of Mass.

THE LITURGICAL YEAR 2020-2021 THE SEASON OF ADVENT

Sunday readings from Cycle B (Mark) Divine Office Vol 1 - Liturgia Horarum Vol 1

Advent has a twofold character: especially during the first part it is a season of joyful expectation of the Lord's second coming at the end of time; but also, and especially during the last eight days of the season, a period of preparing to celebrate Christmas when the first coming of the Son of God is recalled. Advent is thus a period for devout and joyful expectation

During Advent

1. *Masses for Various Needs and Votive Masses may be celebrated only when called for by genuine pastoral need. Daily Masses for the Dead are not allowed.*
2. *Masses of the memorials of saints may be celebrated only on those days assigned to them in the Martyrology*
3. *The playing of the organ and other musical instruments and the decoration of the altar with flowers should be done in moderation, as is consonant with the character of the season, without anticipating the full joy of the Nativity of the Lord*

No particular aspect of the mystery of Christ is celebrated during Ordinary Time; but rather the mystery of Christ in its fullness is recalled, and especially on Sundays

During Ordinary Time

1. *On weekdays the priest may choose Mass from one of the 34 Sundays in Ordinary Time or from the Prayers for Any Necessity. Or the Mass may be that of any saint inscribed in the Martyrology on that day. Or one of the Masses for Any Necessity or Votive Masses may be chosen. Or any of the Masses for the Dead, mindful that the Daily Mass for the Dead may be celebrated only if it is indeed being applied for the departed.*

2. *In Masses celebrated with the people the priest should be concerned for their spiritual good, and neither frequently nor without good cause omit the readings assigned to the day in the Weekday Lectionary, so that the faithful may be better nourished from the table of God's Word*

3. *For the same reason Masses for the Dead should not be celebrated too often since every Mass is offered for the living and the dead, and mention is made of the departed in every Eucharistic Prayer.*

4. *The colour of vestments at Votive Masses may be proper, or of the day, or of the season.*

"The annual Lenten Season is the fitting time to climb the holy mountain of Easter. The Lenten Season has a double character, namely to prepare both catechumens and faithful to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. The catechumens, both with the Rite of Election and Scrutinies, and by catechesis, are prepared for the celebration of the sacraments of Christian Initiation; the faithful, ever more attentive to the word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises."

During Lent

1. All memorials of the saints which occur during Lent are regarded as optional and may be observed only as commemorations (see page 3).
2. Masses for Various Needs are permitted only when there is a genuine pastoral need. Votive Masses and Daily Masses for the Dead are not permitted.
3. In every part of the Mass or the Office where **Alleluia** occurs it is omitted.
4. The organ and other musical instruments are permitted only to support the singing, otherwise their use is not permitted. Flowers are not used in the decoration of the church. An exception is made for Laetare Sunday and for solemnities and feasts.
5. In the celebration of Marriage the couple are to be advised of the need to take account of the penitential character of this liturgical season.

HOLY WEEK

During Holy Week the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his earthly life, beginning with his Messianic Entry into Jerusalem. The days of Holy Week have precedence over all other celebrations. Baptism and Confirmation should not be celebrated on these days since these have their natural place in the Easter Vigil

The rites of Holy Week may be celebrated in all churches and oratories. They may be celebrated in non-parochial churches and oratories only if they can be carried out with dignity, with sufficient servers, with at least some parts sung, and with a reasonable number of the faithful attending.

THE EASTER TRIDUUM

The Lenten Season lasts until Holy Thursday. The Easter Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, is continued through Good Friday, with the celebration of the Passion of the Lord, and Holy Saturday, reaches its summit in the Easter Vigil, and concludes with Vespers of Easter Sunday. Christ accomplished the work of Redemption and the perfect Glorification of God principally through his Paschal Mystery, in which dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life. Hence the sacred Easter Triduum shines forth as the culmination of the whole liturgical year.

On Holy Thursday evening, at the beginning of the Easter Triduum, the Church recalls the Last Supper, in which the Lord Jesus offered to the Father his Body and Blood under the form of bread and wine, gave them to the apostles as spiritual food, and commanded them and their successors in the priesthood to perpetuate this offering.

Celebration of the Passion of the Lord: as in the Missal

1. The Liturgy should take place at 3.00 p.m.; for pastoral reasons it may begin later. The altar is bare, no cross, candles or cloth. The Place of Repose should be undecorated save two candles and a veil on the tabernacle.

2. For the reading of the Passion the same rules apply as on Palm Sunday.

3. Holy Communion is received only during the Liturgy; but it may be taken at any time of day to the sick who are unable to attend.

4. After Communion the Blessed Sacrament is removed to a place outside the church. The altar is stripped privately after the Liturgy, leaving only the cross and candles used in the Liturgy. An appropriate place (e.g. the Place of Repose) may be prepared within the church, and the Lord's Cross placed there so that the faithful may venerate and kiss it and spend some time in meditation.

By ancient tradition this night is "one of vigil for the Lord", to commemorate the resurrection: the "Mother of all holy vigils" when the Church waits for the Resurrection and celebrates it with the sacraments of Christian Initiation. The full meaning of this Vigil is a waiting for the coming of the Lord.

*1. The celebration of the Vigil takes place during the night. It begins **after nightfall** and ends before daybreak on Sunday. The practice of celebrating the Easter Vigil at the time when the Sunday Vigil Masses are usually celebrated is to be censured.*

*2. The Vigil is obligatory in churches with a baptismal font. It may be celebrated in churches and oratories which had no celebrations on Holy Thursday or Good Friday; and may be omitted in those which did. **It is forbidden to celebrate Mass without the Vigil ceremonies.***

3. If necessary the Easter Proclamation may be sung by a cantor who is not a deacon, in which case the cantor is not blessed by the priest and omits the relevant parts of the text. The shorter form of the Proclamation may always be used.

4. At least three readings from the O.T. must be read, and in more urgent cases at least two. The reading from Exodus is never to be omitted.

During Ordinary Time

1. *On weekdays the priest may choose Mass from one of the 34 Sundays in Ordinary Time or from the Prayers for Any Necessity. Or the Mass may be that of any saint inscribed in the Martyrology on that day. Or one of the Masses for Any Necessity or Votive Masses may be chosen. Or any of the Masses for the Dead, mindful that the Daily Mass for the Dead may be celebrated only if it is indeed being applied for the departed.*

2. *In Masses celebrated with the people the priest should be concerned for their spiritual good, and neither frequently nor without good cause omit the readings assigned to the day in the Weekday Lectionary, so that the faithful may be better nourished from the table of God's Word*

3. *For the same reason Masses for the Dead should not be celebrated too often since every Mass is offered for the living and the dead, and mention is made of the departed in every Eucharistic Prayer.*
