

NOTICE BOARD**22nd: Ash Wednesday: obligatory fasting and abstinence****THE SEASON OF LENT**

"The annual Lenten Season is the fitting time to climb the holy mountain of Easter. The Lenten Season has a double character, namely to prepare both catechumens and faithful to celebrate the Paschal Mystery. The catechumens, both with the Rite of Election and Scrutinies, and by catechesis, are prepared for the celebration of the sacraments of Christian Initiation; the faithful, ever more attentive to the word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptismal promises."

During Lent

1. All memorials of the saints which occur during Lent are regarded as optional and may be observed only as commemorations (see page 3).
2. Masses for Various Needs are permitted only when there is a genuine pastoral need. Votive Masses and Daily Masses for the Dead are not permitted.
3. In every part of the Mass or the Office where **Alleluia** occurs it is omitted.
4. The organ and other musical instruments are permitted only to support the singing, otherwise their use is not permitted. Flowers are not used in the decoration of the church. An exception is made for Laetare Sunday and for solemnities and feasts.
5. In the celebration of Marriage the couple are to be advised of the need to take account of the penitential character of this liturgical season.

HOLY WEEK

During Holy Week the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his earthly life, beginning with his Messianic Entry into Jerusalem. The days of Holy Week have precedence over all other celebrations. Baptism and Confirmation should not be celebrated on these days since these have their natural place in the Easter Vigil

The rites of Holy Week may be celebrated in all churches and oratories. However, they may be celebrated in non-parochial churches and oratories only if they can be carried out with dignity, with sufficient servers, with facilities for at least some parts to be sung, and with a reasonable number of the faithful attending - otherwise they may not be celebrated.

1. At all Masses there is to be a commemoration of the Lord's Entry into Jerusalem by a procession or solemn entry at the principal Mass and a simple entry at all other Masses. The solemn entry without procession may take place at all Masses with a large congregation.

2. It is fitting that the procession begin at a chapel or other appropriate place distinct from the church at which the Mass will be celebrated. For the procession the celebrant may wear cope or chasuble.

3. It is not permitted to hold the Blessing of Palms without the procession (or solemn entry) and Mass

4. After the procession (or solemn entry) the Mass begins with the Collect, all preceding rites being omitted.

5. The Passion Narrative is read without candles or incense, and without the greeting and the signing of the book. The responses and the signing of the book are omitted. The Passion may be proclaimed by lay readers; however, the part of Christ should be reserved to the deacon or priest. At the end of the Passion the book is not kissed, but "**The Gospel of the Lord**" is said as usual.

THE EASTER TRIDUUM

The Lenten Season lasts until Holy Thursday. The Easter Triduum begins with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, is continued through Good Friday, with the celebration of the Passion of the Lord, and Holy Saturday, reaches its summit in the Easter Vigil, and concludes with Vespers of Easter Sunday. Christ accomplished the work of Redemption and the perfect Glorification of God principally through his Paschal Mystery, in which dying he destroyed our death and rising he restored our life. Hence the sacred Easter Triduum shines forth as the culmination of the whole liturgical year.

On Holy Thursday evening, at the beginning of the Easter Triduum, the Church recalls the Last Supper, in which the Lord Jesus offered to the Father his Body and Blood under the form of bread and wine, gave them to the apostles as spiritual food, and commanded them and their successors in the priesthood to perpetuate this offering.

1. Only the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper is permitted today. Mass may not be celebrated without a congregation, nor may funeral Masses be celebrated.

2. The tabernacle should be empty and sufficient hosts consecrated for this Mass and tomorrow's Liturgy. During the Gloria the bells of the church are rung then remain silent until the Gloria at the Easter Vigil.

3. It is fitting that the Washing of Feet take place after the Gospel and Homily.

4. The faithful are encouraged to watch before the Blessed Sacrament at the Place of Repose for a suitable period. From Midnight adoration may be made but without external solemnity.

5. After Mass the altar is stripped without ceremony, holy water stoups are emptied and covered, and any uncovered crucifixes are veiled or removed.

7 Fri Red GOOD FRIDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION [First Friday]

On this day the Church meditates on the Passion of her Lord and Spouse, venerates the Cross, commemorates her origin from the side of Christ on the Cross, and intercedes for the salvation of the whole world.

Office: of the day. It is recommended that on this day OR and Lds be celebrated in church with the participation of the people. ORp,Lp,Hp

Celebration of the Passion of the Lord: as in the Missal

1. The Liturgy should take place at 3.00 p.m.; for pastoral reasons it may begin later. The altar is bare, no cross, candles or cloth. The Place of Repose should be undecorated save two candles and a veil on the tabernacle.

2. For the reading of the Passion the same rules apply as on Palm Sunday.

3. Holy Communion is received only during the Liturgy; but it may be taken at any time of day to the sick who are unable to attend.

4. After Communion the Blessed Sacrament is removed to a place outside the church. The altar is stripped privately after the Liturgy, leaving only the cross and candles used in the Liturgy. An appropriate place (e.g. the Place of Repose) may be prepared within the church, and the Lord's Cross placed there so that the faithful may venerate and kiss it and spend some time in meditation.

The celebration of Easter begins at the Easter Vigil and is prolonged throughout the Easter Season. The fifty days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday are celebrated as one feast, the "Great Sunday".

Solemnity of solemnities

8 Sat AT THE EASTER VIGIL

By ancient tradition this night is "one of vigil for the Lord", to commemorate the resurrection: the "Mother of all holy vigils" when the Church waits for the Resurrection and celebrates it with the sacraments of Christian Initiation. The full meaning of this Vigil is a waiting for the coming of the Lord.

1. The celebration of the Vigil takes place during the night. It begins **after nightfall** and ends before daybreak on Sunday. The practice of celebrating the Easter Vigil at the time when the Sunday Vigil Masses are usually celebrated is to be censured.

2. The Vigil is obligatory in churches with a baptismal font. It may be celebrated in churches and oratories which had no celebrations on Holy Thursday or Good Friday; and may be omitted in those which did. **It is forbidden to celebrate Mass without the Vigil ceremonies.**

3. If necessary the Easter Proclamation (Exultet) may be sung by a cantor who is not a deacon, in which case the cantor is not blessed by the priest and omits the relevant parts of the text. The shorter form of the Proclamation may always be used.

4. At least three readings from the O.T. must be read, and in more urgent cases at least two. The reading from Exodus is never to be omitted.
